

## Virginia Tech MFT MS Program Criteria for Graduate Student Annual Review

Criteria
1. Academic Criteria
A. Maintain a 3.0 Quality Credit Average (QCA).
B. Earn grades of "C" or better in each of the courses on the student's program of study.
C. Complete individual course requirements within the semester in which courses are taken (no incomplete grades).
D. Submit an approved program of study to the Graduate School prior to completing 12 credit hours.
E. Meet all of the other stated expectations of the Graduate School, including examinations and time limits.
F. Pass the comprehensive examinations.
G. Progress toward thesis/project completion (e.g., timely completion of proposal drafts, proposal meeting, data collection, defense; see the MFT Plan of Thesis/Project Completion for more details).
H. Pass the final examination consisting of thesis defense or presentation of the non-thesis project.
2. Clinical Criteria
A. Admission into the clinical practicum.
B. Progress toward developing clinical competencies. This progress is evaluated every semester by the practicum supervisor(s) (. (See CFS Policy & Procedure Manual for details on practicum evaluation.)
3. Service Criteria
A. Participate in required meetings and events, usually indicated on the program calendar (e.g., program orientation meeting, thesis/project orientation meeting)
B. Participate in program volunteer activities and events (e.g., student interview day)
